

Why be a MACCA Board member?

- Time in your life when you want to give something back to the community
- Opportunity to develop your skills and experience, or use the skills you've developed
- Feel like you're making a contribution to Metchosin's art and cultural life
- Get to know new people, see a different side of Metchosin life

What's expected of Board members

- Know and support the mandate of MACCA, and represent MACCA within the community
- Be active in one or more areas of Board responsibility: managing finances, managing tenant relations, liaising with the District; managing the facility, organizing volunteer events and activities; supporting arts and culture through events and grants.
- Prepare for and attend monthly meetings of the Board, annual; meeting and special events as required.
- Participate in setting policy, making decisions on MACCA's activities and attending other meetings as required.
- A cooperative and positive attitude, and a willingness to learn from others.
- Willingness to volunteer for hands-on projects to improve the art centre and support events.

How to join the Board

- Board members are elected at the Annual General Meeting which happens in June/July every year. Members currently serve for 1 year at a time; most Board members choose to stay on for a number of years.
- Board members must be members of MACCA, which is a one-time, lifetime membership (individual or family).

The Metchosin Arts and Cultural Centre Association is responsible for operating the Metchosin Arts & Cultural Centre, which provides space for active artists, crafts persons and musicians in Metchosin who contribute to the cultural life of our community. The Board values members with arts/culture experience and orientation, as well as those with experience or skills in managing arts facilities, finance, and related administrative skills.
